### **“What will change in Healthcare under the Tories?”**

Andrew Lansley was elected as MP for South Cambridgeshire in May 1997. In 2003, Mr Lansley was appointed Shadow Secretary of State for Health, and has now been in the post for more than five years. During that time, he has visited hospitals and GPs across the country, listening to clinicians and NHS professionals. In 2008, he was named the eighth most influential person in the Health Service Journal's 'Fifty People with the Greatest Influence on Today's NHS Policy and Practice', ahead of several Ministers at the Department of Health.

Coming from a public service family, he is committed to improving the NHS for everyone. His father was working in the NHS from the day it was created in 1948. He went on to run the pathology lab at East Ham Memorial Hospital for thirty years.

His proudest career achievements include running the Conservative Party campaign for the 1992 General Election, for which he was awarded a CBE, and transforming the public's view of the Conservative Party's commitment to the NHS.

At this dinner Mr Lansley will no doubt be asked if any country can sustain a fully tax funded health service given the demographic and technological changes and if not what part will the independent sector play. Does he see any likelihood of a more mixed public/private sector healthcare economy? Should private medical insurance be encouraged by adding tax relief or does the economic climate entirely preclude this? A return to professionalism was put at the heart of the conservative party thinking on healthcare- how will this be achieved and how can consultants contribute?
